Scheduling Changes to Preliminary Schedules (By Appointment)

The computer generates a randomized list and then assigns each student an appointment time for making schedule changes. You will have an afternoon appointment on a specific day and may come for changes from 12:00 – 2:30 (afternoon appointments) on your assigned day. If you cannot come in to the SAO during your assigned appointment time to make changes to your schedule, you may come any afternoon (between 12:00 – 2:30 pm) after your assigned day or call in during the call-in time (3:00 – 4:30 pm) the day of your appointment or any day after. For each session you will be seen in the order of "first-come, first-served".

NOTE: This schedule of appointments will be strictly observed. NO ONE may be seen a second time until all students have been seen once. NO ONE may be helped during the phone-in time if they have already been seen in-person. NO ONE may phone -in more than once. NO ONE will be seen for changes before their appointment time. NO WAIT LIST will be kept.
